### Expanding Access to Inpatient Neurology at Anna Jaques Hospital

We're excited to launch a new TeleNeurology partnership between HMFP neurologists at BIDMC and Anna Jaques Hospital. This collaboration addresses a growing need for inpatient neurology care at AJH—expanding services beyond TeleStroke to include expert non-emergent neurology consults.



### **Neuro ICU Expanding to Support Growing Patient Needs**

The Neuro ICU is expanding to an adjacent pod on Rosenberg 7, increasing capacity from 8 to 12 beds (6 per unit) with plans to grow to 16 beds by early 2026. This expansion will improve care for neurology and neurosurgery patients currently boarded elsewhere, ensuring timely, specialized treatment for complex cases.
